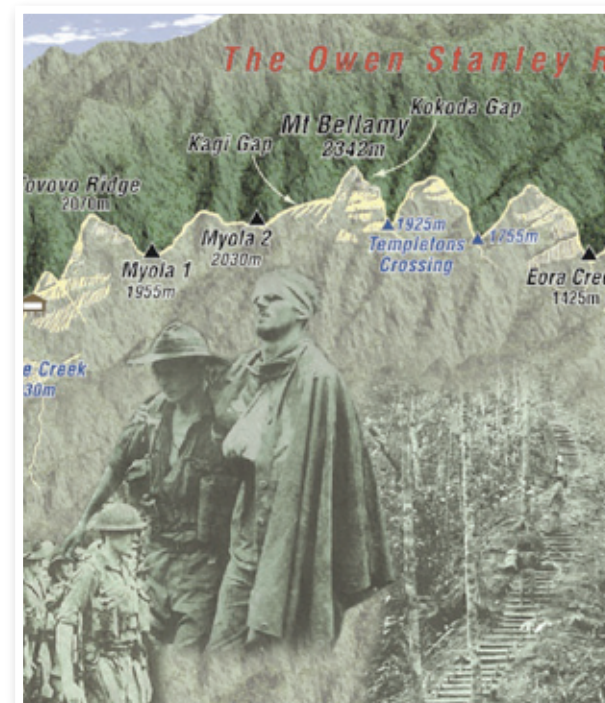
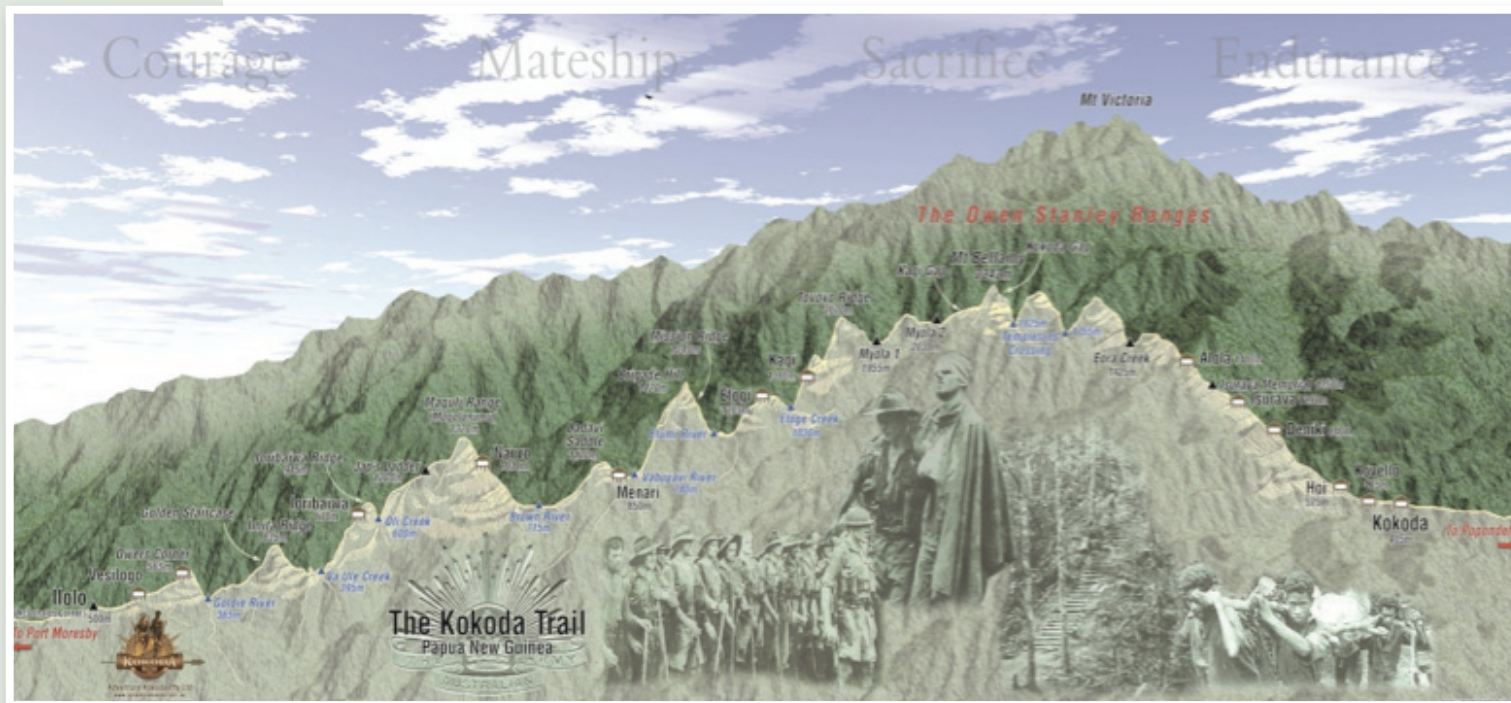


THE KOKODA TRAIL SPECIAL EDITION WALL MAP



The Kokoda Trail Special Edition Wall Map is a professional illustration of the Kokoda campaign.

It includes data from wartime sketches in the Australian War Memorial, official army survey maps, the PNG National Mapping Bureau and satellite images. Indigenous names of mountains and rivers have been provided by clan leaders from along the track. The words etched in the granite pillars of the Isurava Memorial: 'Courage, Mateship, Sacrifice, Endurance' are watermarked in the sky

as a solemn reminder of the qualities of our veterans, and the PNG 'fuzzy-wuzzy angels', who saved Australia from invasion during the war in the Pacific in 1942. Images depicting the historic parade of the 39th Battalion at Menari Village, wartime carriers assisting wounded diggers and the 'Golden Staircase' are embedded into the Owen Stanley Ranges between Owers Corner and Kokoda. The map measures 850mm X 300mm.

THE KOKODA TRAIL VETERANS MAP

The Kokoda Trail Veterans Map honours relatives who served in Papua and New Guinea during the war in the Pacific. You provide a photograph of the veteran and details of their service record. The Cary Corporation will mount the photograph together with the Rising Sun badge, two Australia shoulder bars, two unit colour patches, two unit colour bars, two unit colour patches and a set of highly polished replica medals. A historic photo of the campaign will also be mounted in the frame. This is a stunning tribute to veterans.

The displayed picture is dedicated to Private Bruce Kingsbury VC who was posthumously awarded the first and only Victoria Cross of the Kokoda campaign. It is a popular item for RSL Clubs and Sub-Branches.
